Why collect donations for Women's Animal Center?

Women's Animal Center is a non-profit organization that cares for homeless animals in our shelter and provides affordable veterinary care for family-owned pets. We rely on the generosity of our community to help us raise money and donate supplies to care for the thousands of animals we take in each year. When you donate supplies, we are able to use our funds to enrich the lives of shelter animals and provide improved veterinary services. We could not continue our lifesaving mission without the generous support of our donors.

Important Notes:

If you need community service hours for this project, please fill out the **Donation Drive Hours Log and Community Service Donation Drive Follow-Up Questionnaire** in this packet and bring it in with your donations. After all paperwork and donations are verified, a Letter of Documentation will be mailed or emailed (your choice) to you within 10 business days of the drop-off date.

Please note that donation drop-offs are usually scheduled on weekdays. You will need to bring your completed paperwork with you when you drop off.

If you would like a photo at Women's Animal Center to be possibly posted on our social media, please bring the **Photo Permission** form signed by your parent/guardian. We cannot guarantee that your picture will be shared.

How to Run a Donation Drive

- 1. Ask permission from your parent/guardian and/or teacher.
- 2. Print this packet so you are able to fill out all necessary forms.
- 3. Decide which items you would like to collect. Refer to the Supply the Shelter form included in this packet and choose from this list only.
- 4. Decide when, where, and from whom you will ask for donations.
- 5. Contact our Community Programs Coordinator (see Important Notes below) to let them know you are planning a donation drive. They will ask for information about what items you will be collecting and when you will be dropping them off at Women's Animal Center.
- 6. Make fliers and posters advertising your donation collection. You can use the poster template included in this packet, or you can make your own! (You can ask permission from your parent/guardian and/or teacher to post your donation collection on social media.)
- 7. Ask people to donate needed items advertise at school, church or temple, ask your friends, family, neighbors, local businesses, etc.
- 8. You can organize a specific time/place for people to drop off items, or give them a deadline to drop off. Organize the donations, and make sure they are on our "Supply the Shelter" list (attached).
- 9. Being the items to Women's Animal Center at your scheduled drop-off time along with all necessary paperwork.
